

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CESSPOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 235-16.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 2 "(e) The department of health shall: 3 Certify all qualified cesspools for the purposes of 4 this section[; provided that, as a pilot program, the 5 department of health, in its discretion, may certify 6 no more than two residential large capacity cesspools 7 as qualified cesspools]; Collect and maintain a record of all qualified 9 (2) expenses certified by an appropriate government agency 10 . for the taxable year; and 11 Certify to each taxpayer the amount of credit the 12 (3) taxpayer may claim; provided that if, in any year, the 13 annual amount of certified credits reaches \$5,000,000 14 in the aggregate, the department of health shall
