A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPACT FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-1603, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§302A-1603 Applicability and exemptions. (a) Except as
4	provided in subsection (b), any person who seeks to develop a
5	new residential development within a designated school impact
6	district requiring:
7	(1) A county subdivision approval;
8	(2) A county building permit; or
9	(3) A condominium property regime approval for the
10	project,
11	shall be required to fulfill the land component impact fee or
12	fee in lieu requirement and construction cost component impact
13	fee requirement of the department [$-$ including all government
14	housing projects and projects processed pursuant to sections 46
15	15.1 and 201H-38].
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(b) The following shall be exempt from this section:

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1	(1)	Any form of housing permanently excluding school-aged
2		children, with the necessary covenants or declarations
3		of restrictions recorded on the property;
4	(2)	Any form of housing that is or will be paying the
5		transient accommodations tax under chapter 237D;
6	(3)	All nonresidential development; [and]
7	(4)	Any development with an executed education
8		contribution agreement or other like document with the
9		department for the contribution of school sites or
10		payment of fees for school land or school
11		construction [-];
12	(5)	Government housing projects;
13	(6)	Projects processed pursuant to sections 46-15.1 and
14		<u>201H-38;</u>
15	(7)	Affordable housing projects that satisfy the county
16		affordable housing requirements and qualify for county
17		fee exemptions for the county in which the projects
18		are situated; and
19	(8)	Affordable rental housing projects, including senior
20		and family rental housing, for which developers

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1	receive low income housing tax credits under section
2	42 of the Internal Revenue Code."
3	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
5	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
