- 2 by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 4 provided that on June 30, [2018,] 2023, this Act shall be
- 5 repealed and section 448E-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be
- 6 reenacted in the form in which it read on the day before the
- 7 effective date of this Act."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.

Description:

Extends the sunset date of the limited exemption from licensing requirements for electrical contractors who are retained by a public utility within the State to perform high voltage (600 volts or higher) electrical work and are deemed qualified by the public utility. (HB1880 HD1)
