- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended

- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§8- Hawaii alcohol and opioid addiction awareness and
- 5 recovery month. The month of September shall be known and
- 6 designated as "Hawaii Alcohol and Opioid Addiction Awareness and
- 7 Recovery Month" to promote public awareness of alcohol and
- 8 opioid addiction as a significant societal, public health, and
- 9 general welfare problem and to promote recovery from these
- 10 addictions."
- 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
