A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause 1 2 of death in Hawaii. An estimated twenty-seven thousand individuals in Hawaii currently live with Alzheimer's disease 3 and about sixty-six thousand unpaid family caregivers care for 4 those individuals. By 2025, the number of individuals with 5 Alzheimer's disease is expected to increase to thirty-five thousand. 7 In 2013, the department of health executive office on aging 8 9 issued the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. The plan set forth a course of action to improve the 10 quality of life for individuals with Alzheimer's disease and 11 12 related dementias. The five goals of the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and related dementias are:

- Prevent and effectively treat Alzheimer's disease by 15 the year 2025; 16
- Enhance care quality and efficiency; 17 (2)

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1	(3) Expand supports for individuals with Alzheimer's
2	disease and their families;
3	(4) Enhance public awareness and engagement; and
4	(5) Improve data to track progress.
5	The plan was envisioned to be updated annually. However,
6	although stakeholders to the plan, including the executive
7	office on aging, met in 2015, 2016, and 2017, an update to the
8	plan was not issued. Additional resources are needed to furthe
9	the efforts specified by the plan.
10	The purpose of this Act is to prepare for the expected
11	increase in individuals affected by Alzheimer's disease and
12	related dementias by:
13	(1) Requiring the executive office on aging to annually
14	update the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and
15	related dementias;
16	(2) Requiring the executive office on aging to include a
17	work plan specifying the tasks, timelines, and
18	milestones for each goal of the state plan on
19	Alzheimer's disease and related dementias as part of
20	the plan's annual update; and

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1	(3)	Appropriating funds for the executive office on aging	
2		to update the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and	
3		related dementias.	
4	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 349, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
5	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
6	designated and to read as follows:		
7	" <u>§34</u>	9- Alzheimer's disease and related dementias state	
8	plan. (a) The executive office on aging shall submit to the	
9	governor	and the legislature an annual update of the state plan	
10	on Alzheimer's disease and related dementias no later than		
11	twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session of		
12	the legis	lature.	
13	<u>(b)</u>	The update shall include:	
14	(1)	An implementation work plan specifying the tasks,	
15		timelines, and milestones for each goal along with	
16		parties assigned to each task;	
17	(2)	Efforts taken by the State to achieve the goals and	
18		strategies identified in the most recent state plan on	
19		Alzheimer's disease and related dementias;	
20	(3)	Recommendations for state policy relating to	
21		Alzheimer's disease and dementias; and	

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1	(4)	A review of services initiated and coordinated among		
2		public and private agencies to meet the needs of		
3		persons with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias		
4		and their families.		
5	<u>(c)</u>	In preparing the update, the executive office on aging		
6	shall review the most recent state plan on Alzheimer's disease			
7	and related dementias for appropriateness and revise the plan as			
8	necessary	. In determining the appropriateness of the current		
9	plan, the executive office on aging shall solicit input from			
10	task forces and working groups formed to address Alzheimer's			
11	disease and related dementias, families affected by Alzheimer's			
. 12	disease and related dementias, and members of the medical			
13	community."			
14	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much			
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the			
17	executive office on aging to update the state plan on			
18	Alzheimer's disease and related dementias.			
19	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
20	health fo	or the purposes of this Act.		
21	SECT	TION 4. New statutory material is underscored.		

1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
