## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause
2	of death in the United States. An estimated twenty-seven
3	thousand individuals in Hawaii currently live with Alzheimer's
4	disease and dementia, and about sixty-six thousand unpaid family
5	caregivers care for those individuals. By 2025, the number of
6	individuals with Alzheimer's disease is expected to increase to
7	thirty-five thousand.
8	In 2013, the department of health executive office on aging
9	issued the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and related
10	dementias. The plan set forth a course of action to improve the
11	quality of life for individuals with Alzheimer's disease and
12	related dementias.
13	The five goals of the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and
14	related dementias are:
15	(1) Prevent and effectively treat Alzheimer's disease by
16	the year 2025;

(2) Enhance care quality and efficiency;

8	SECTION 2. Chapter 349, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
10	designated and to read as follows:
11	"§349- Alzheimer's disease and related dementias state
12	plan. (a) The executive office on aging shall prepare an
13	update of the state plan on Alzheimer's disease and related
14	dementias no less frequently than once per fiscal biennium. The
15	executive office on aging shall include information on progress
16	made toward the goals of the state plan in its annual report to
17	the legislature.

19	(1) An implementation work plan specifying the tasks,
20	timelines, and milestones for each goal along with
21	parties assigned to each task;
