BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) No person shall stand in the bed or load-carrying
4	area of any motor vehicle commonly known as a pickup truck while
5	the vehicle is in operation. No operator of any pickup truck
6	shall operate the vehicle with a passenger seated in the bed or
7	load-carrying area of the vehicle unless:
8	(1) There is no seating available in the cab of the
9	vehicle;
10	(2) The side racks of the vehicle are securely attached
11	and the tailboard or tailgate is securely closed;
12	(3) Every passenger in the bed or load-carrying area of
13	the vehicle is seated on the floor and does not
14	attempt to control unlashed cargo $[-]_{i}$
15	provided that any county may adopt a rule or ordinance that
16	places stricter limitations on a passenger seated in the bed or
17	loading-carrying area of the vehicle. In case of conflict

1 between the requirements or limitations of this section or any 2 county rule or ordinance regarding a passenger seated in the bed 3 or loading-carrying area of a pickup truck, the more restrictive 4 requirements shall apply." 5 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 7 begun before its effective date. 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 10 11 INTRODUCED BY:
