
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"§103D- Joint offers and awards not prohibited; rules.

(a) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to prohibit:

(1) Two or more separate entities from submitting a single joint offer in response to a solicitation; provided that a joint offer shall be considered by a purchasing agency as one offer; or

(2) A purchasing agency from awarding a single contract to two or more separate entities that have submitted a joint offer.

(b) The procurement policy board shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 91, that prescribe procedures for joint offers and contract awards to joint offerors."


1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
