

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MASSAGE THERAPY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 452, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§45</u>	2- Exemption from licensure. A person shall be	
5	exempt from licensure under this chapter if the person:		
6	(1)	Engages in the manipulation of the soft tissues of	
7		only the hands, feet, or outer ears, including the	
8		practice of reflexology and foot zone therapy;	
9	(2)	Performs the services described under paragraph (1)	
10		for clients who remain fully clothed from the	
11		shoulders to the knees;	
12	(3)	Is certified by, and in good standing with, an	
13		industry-recognized organization that represents	
14		practitioners who perform the services described under	
15		paragraph (1) with established standards and ethics;

1	(4) Does no	ot otherwise provide massage therapy for
2	clients	s, whether or not for compensation."
3	SECTION 2.	This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4	matured, penaltie	es that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5	begun before its	effective date.
6	SECTION 3.	New statutory material is underscored.
7	CECTION 1	This Act shall take effect upon its approval
