A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) Pursuant to section 226-55, Hawaii Revised
2	Statutes, the department of agriculture, in coordination with
3	the office of planning and department of land and natural
4	resources, shall prepare and periodically update a seafood
5	management study that expands the State's priority on food by
6	including wild seafood as a viable food source.
7	(b) As part of the seafood management study, the
8	department of agriculture shall consider the following:
9	(1) Establishing objectives, policies, and actions related
10	to seafood sustainability;
11	(2) Researching the agricultural and economic impact that
12	wild seafood has on food self-sufficiency in the
13	State, including its influence on non-commercial
14	consumption, such as community sharing and fisher
15	household consumption, and exports;

(3) Collecting data on the wholesale and retail sales of wild seafood in the State;

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- (4) Classifying and regulating wild seafood as a food
 commodity in the State; and
- 3 (5) Incorporating the seafood management study, in part or
 4 in whole, into the state agricultural functional plan
 5 related to increased food security and food self6 sufficiency.
- 7 (c) The department of agriculture shall submit the seafood 8 management study, including any proposed legislation, to the 9 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 10 the regular session of 2019.
- (d) For the purposes of this section, "wild seafood" means naturally-born or hatchery-raised fish and shellfish harvested in the wild through commercial, recreational, or subsistence fishing, but excluding net-pen aquacultural or other farm-raised fish.
- section 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the department of agriculture, in coordination with the office of planning and department of land and natural resources, to prepare and periodically update a seafood management study.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
