
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FLOOD MITIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii emergency management agency
2 shall develop a strategic regional flood plan that shall address
3 flood mitigation, flood water retention, and flood diversion.


4 The plan shall become effective on December 31, 2019.

5 (b) The agency shall submit to the legislature a written
6 report of its progress in developing the plan, including any
7 findings, recommendations, and proposed legislation, no later
8 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
9 of 2019.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
