
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FLOOD MITIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii emergency management agency
2 shall develop strategic regional flood plans that shall address
3 flood mitigation, flood water retention, flood diversion, and
4 catastrophic floods.

5 The plans shall become effective on December 31, 2020.

6 (b) The agency shall submit to the legislature a written
7 report of its progress in developing plans, including any
8 findings, recommendations, and proposed legislation, no later
9 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
10 of 2019.

11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
