## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§353C- Annual report; inmate deaths; serious or violent		
5	incidents. The director of public safety shall submit an annual		
6	public report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior		
7	to the convening of each regular session of the legislature.		
8	The report shall include:		
9	(1) Information related to inmates held in-state and out-		
10	of-state, including but not limited to, statistics on:		
11	(A) Inmate deaths; and		
12	(B) Serious or violent incidents involving inmates;		
13	and		
14	(2) A review of the department of public safety's		
15	procedures to prevent inmate deaths and serious or		
16	violent incidents involving inmates."

- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall not be applied so as to impair
- 5 any contract existing as of the effective date of this Act in a
- 6 manner violative of either the Hawaii State Constitution or
- 7 Article I, section 10, of the United States Constitution.
- 8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

### Report Title:

Inmates; Out-of-State Correctional Institutions; Public Safety;
Annual Report

### Description:

Requires that any inmate transferred to any out-of-state correctional institution be subject to the continuing jurisdiction of Hawaii and authorizes the removal of the inmate from the correctional institution. Requires the Director of Public Safety to submit an annual public report with information related to Hawaii inmates, including statistics and Department procedures on inmate deaths and serious or violent incidents involving inmates.
