
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DIVISION OF CONSERVATION AND RESOURCES
ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the poor conditions
2 of roads in many of the rural areas on the island of Hawaii
3 hamper the ability of the division of conservation and resources
4 enforcement of the department of land and natural resources to
5 pursue alleged suspects in the course of their duties.

6 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
7 to the department of land and natural resources' division of
8 conservation and resources enforcement to upgrade the division's
9 trucks currently in use in Hawaii county.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$39,084 or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to upgrade
13 the division of conservation and resources enforcement's trucks
14 currently in use in Hawaii county; provided that the sum
15 appropriated by this Act shall be expended by the department of



1 land and natural resources within one year of the effective date
2 of this Act.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
