#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the clean water SECTION 1. 2 branch of the department of health has inadequate staff capacity 3 to meet its obligations to perform timely monitoring to assure that west Hawaii island's stream and coastal waters are safe for 4 5 public swimming, fishing, and other recreational activities. 6 particular, contaminants of emerging concern from waste water 7 treatment plant outfalls, injection wells, and any cesspools 8 need to be addressed because of their role in harming coral 9 reefs. 10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to the 11 department of health to establish one full-time position to 12

conduct water quality assessments in west Hawaii island.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,722 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the clean water branch of the department of health to hire one fulltime equivalent (1.0 FTE) environmental health specialist IV
