BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-24.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§291-24.5 Motor vehicle muffler. (a) No person shall
- 4 use on a public highway, sell, alter or install a muffler which
- 5 [will noticeably increase the noise emitted by a motor vehicle
- 6 above that emitted by the vehicle as equipped from the factory.]
- 7 emits more than 95 decibels of noise.
- **8** (b) Any violation of this section shall constitute a
- 9 violation and shall be enforceable by police officers. The fine
- 10 for this violation shall be not less than \$25 nor more than \$250
- 11 for each separate offense. Any person who violates the
- 12 provisions of this section may be issued a summons or citation
- 13 for such violation.
- (c) The director of transportation shall adopt
- 15 administrative rules in accordance with chapter 91 for testing
- 16 standards to effectuate this section. These rules shall include
- 17 specifications for:
