BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

15	(4)	If the offense is a class B felony, the defendant
16		shall be sentenced for a class A felony.

- 1 As used in this section, "nonprofit entity" means any charitable
- 2 organization operating pursuant to Title 26 United States Code
- 3 section 501(c)(3), (4), (8), (9), (26), or 501(e) and registered
- 4 pursuant to chapter 414D."
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
