A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§183D- Hawaii apprentice hunting license program;
5	established. (a) There is established the Hawaii apprentice
6	hunting license program within and administered by the
7	department. The purpose of the Hawaii apprentice hunting
8	license program shall be to provide licensees with information
9	and training to assist the licensee to qualify for a hunting
10	license under section 183D-22; provided that the Hawaii
11	apprentice hunting license shall not be a requirement to qualify
12	for a hunting license under section 183D-22. The Hawaii

- 13 apprentice hunting license program shall not be used in place of
- the hunting license issued under section 183D-22.
- (b) A Hawaii apprentice hunting license shall be issued by
- 16 an agent of the department to a person:
- 17 (1) Who is at least ten years of age;



1	(2)	opon completion of a written application by the
2		applicant, or if the applicant is a minor, by the
3		applicant's parent or legal guardian, in a form,
4		prescribed by the department, which shall include the
5		following information:
6		(A) The designation of a person who is at least
7		twenty-one years of age and holds a current and
8		valid hunting license under section 183D-22, as a
9		mentor for the applicant; and
10		(B) A statement under oath by the applicant, or if
11		the applicant is a minor, by the applicant's
12		parent or legal guardian, of the applicant's
13		name, address, domicile or residence, length of
14		residence in the State, age, race, height,
15		weight, and color of hair and eyes; and
16	(3)	Upon payment of a hunting license fee or any other
17		hunting-related fee that the board may require under
18		this chapter; provided that the Hawaii apprentice
19		hunting license fee shall be \$95; provided further
20		that the fee shall be \$10 for any person who has
21		resided in this State for more than one year or who is

1		an active-duty member of the armed forces of the
2		United States.
3	(c)	The Hawaii apprentice hunting license shall be valid
4	for the d	uration of the hunting season of the year in which the
5	license w	as issued. The license shall be renewable for one
6	additiona	l year.
7	(d)	A person who is issued a Hawaii apprentice hunting
8	license s	hall:
9	(1)	Not permit any other person to carry, display, or use
10		the license in any way;
11	(2)	Be in physical possession of the license when hunting
12		and show the license upon the demand of any officer
13		authorized to enforce the game laws of the State; and
14	(3)	Be accompanied by and under the supervision of the
15		mentor named in the application as required in
16		subsection (b)(2)(A).
17	(e)	Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in this
18	chapter,	while in the field:
19	(1)	A mentor shall not supervise more than two Hawaii
20		apprentice hunting licensees at any one time; and

1	(2) When a Hawaii apprentice hunting licensee uses a
2	firearm in hunting, the mentor and the licensee shall
3	possess not more than one firearm per person."
4	SECTION 2. Section 183D-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"§183D-21 Hunting licenses required. [No] Except as
7	<pre>provided in section 183D- , no person shall hunt, pursue, kill,</pre>
8	or take any game bird or mammal without first procuring a
9	hunting license; provided that section 183D-32 to the contrary
10	notwithstanding, no license shall be required of persons who may
11	be authorized in writing by the board to destroy game birds or
12	game mammals injurious to forest growth or agriculture, or that
13	constitute a nuisance or a health hazard."
14	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
