A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VIETNAM WAR VETERANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that on May 25, 2012,
- 2 President Barack Obama, by Presidential proclamation, proclaimed
- 3 May 28, 2012, through November 11, 2025, as the Commemoration of
- 4 the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War. The President called
- 5 upon "[f]ederal, [s]tate, and local officials to honor our
- 6 Vietnam veterans, our fallen, our wounded, those unaccounted
- 7 for, our former prisoners of war, their families, and all who
- 8 served[.]" Throughout 2017, various programs, ceremonies, and
- 9 activities were held on each island in the State of Hawaii to
- 10 honor and recognize our Vietnam veterans.
- 11 The legislature additionally finds that on March 28, 2017,
- 12 President Donald J. Trump signed the Vietnam War Veterans
- 13 Recognition Act of 2017, which recognizes March 29 annually as
- 14 National Vietnam War Veterans Day.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to designate March 29 of each
- 16 year as "Vietnam War Veterans Day".

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§8- Vietnam War Veterans Day. March 29 of each year
- 5 shall be known and designated as "Vietnam War Veterans Day",
- 6 provided that this day is not and shall not be construed to be a
- 7 state holiday."
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on December 23,
- **10** 2083.
