# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COURT PROCEEDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1       SECTION 1. Chapter 601, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4       "§601- Constitutional and statutory claims;  
5 legislature; right of intervention. The legislature shall have  
6 standing to intervene in any court proceeding involving a claim  
7 that is based upon a constitutional or statutory provision."

8       SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
