A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REGENTS CANDIDATE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 304A-104.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
3	"(e)	The candidate advisory council shall consist of
4	[seven] <u>e</u>	ight voting members to be appointed without regard to
5	section 2	6-34 as follows:
6	(1)	One member who shall be appointed by the president of
7		the senate;
8	(2)	One member who shall be appointed by the speaker of
9		the house of representatives; [and]
10	(3)	Five members who shall be appointed by the governor[-
11		A]; and
12	(4)	One member of the Association of Emeritus Regents of
13		the University of Hawaii, appointed by the chair of
14		the Association of Emeritus Regents of the University
15		of Hawaii[, shall serve as an ex officio, nonvoting
16		member of the candidate advisory council, for a term
17		not to exceed two years; provided that the appointment

1		shall run concurrently with the term of the appointing
2		chair].
3	The p	resident of the senate, speaker of the house of
4	representa	tives, and governor are encouraged to appoint full-
5	time stude	nts of the university, university faculty, university
6	staff, or	university alumni to the candidate advisory council;
7	provided t	hat if a full-time student is appointed to the
8	candidate	advisory council, the student shall have been enrolled
9	as a full-	time student for at least three consecutive semesters
10	and shall	serve for a term of two years.
11	(f)	[Voting members] Members of the candidate advisory
12	council sh	all serve for the following terms:
13	(1)	Those appointed by the president of the senate and
14		speaker of the house of representatives shall serve
15		for a term of four years; [and]
16	(2)	Those appointed by the governor shall serve for a term
17		of four years; provided that such appointments shall
18		run concurrently with the term of the appointing

20	(3)	The member appointed by the chair of the Association
