A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The purpose of this Act is to support the SECTION 1. 2 responsibilities of the executive office on early learning and 3 early learning board by appropriating funds to the executive 4 office on early learning for additional operational costs, 5 including equipment, supplies, and personnel costs incurred as a 6 result of Act 202, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017. 7 There is appropriated out of the general 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to the 10 executive office on early learning for additional operational 11 costs, including equipment, supplies, and personnel costs, that 12 shall be allocated as follows: 13 (1) for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 14 office assistant IV position; 15 (2) for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) data 16 processing user support technician II position; 17 (3) for travel for early learning board members;

1 (4) \$ for phone lines;
2 (5) \$ for computer equipment; and
3 (6) \$ for supplies and printing costs.
4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
5 office on early learning for the purposes of this Act.
6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
