
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISASTER PREPAREDNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The department of education shall establish a
2 pilot program to retrofit the following buildings to meet or
3 exceed the various building codes established for enabling a
4 building to withstand the weather conditions of a category four
5 hurricane:

6 (1) Mililani uka elementary school cafeteria;

7 (2) Mililani high school gymnasium;

8 (3) Kaleiopuu elementary school cafeteria;

9 (4) Waipahu high school gymnasium; and

10 (5) August Ahrens elementary school cafeteria.

11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019
15 for the purpose of retrofitting department of education
16 buildings to withstand a category four hurricane pursuant to
17 section 1 of this Act.

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 education for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
4 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
5 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
6 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
7 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.


8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
