RELATING TO DISASTER PREPAREDNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of education, in
- 2 collaboration with the Hawaii emergency management agency, shall
- 3 establish a pilot program to retrofit department of education
- 4 buildings to meet or exceed the various building codes
- 5 established for enabling a building to withstand the weather
- 6 conditions of a category three hurricane.
- 7 (b) The department of education shall select one school in
- 8 each of the four largest counties to be part of the pilot
- 9 program and, in collaboration with the Hawaii emergency
- 10 management agency, make a determination of buildings at the
- 11 selected schools suitable for use as disaster shelters pursuant

- 16 (c) As part of the pilot program, the Hawaii emergency
- 17 management agency shall determine any sources of federal funding

- 1 that may be obtained to assist with retrofitting selected

- 4 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 5 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019
- 8 for the purpose of retrofitting department of education
- 9 buildings to withstand a category three hurricane pursuant to
- 10 section 1 of this Act.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
