### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATERSHEDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TION 1. (a) There is established a watershed task				
2	force wit	thin the department of land and natural resources for				
3	administrative purposes.					
4	(b)	The task force is established for the purpose of				
5	defining	the term "watershed".				
6	(c)	The task force shall be composed of the following				
7	members:					
8	(1)	The chair of the senate committee on water and land or				
9		the chair's designee;				
10	(2)	The chair of the house committee on water and land or				
11		the chair's designee;				
12	(3)	The administrator of the department of land and				
13		natural resources' division of forestry and wildlife				
14		or the administrator's designee;				
15	(4)	The president of the University of Hawaii system or				
16		the president's designee; and				

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1	(5)	The f	Following individuals, whom the chairperson shall		
2		invit	te to serve as members of the task force:		
3		(A)	The Director of the United States Geological		
4			Survey Pacific Islands Water Science Center;		
5		(B)	A representative of the National Oceanic and		
6			Atmospheric Administration;		
7		(C)	Major public and private landowners in the State;		
8			and		
9		(D)	Members of Hawaii watershed partnerships.		
10	(d)	The	task force shall select from among its members a		
11	chairpers	on and	d any other officers it deems necessary.		
12	(e)	Memb	ers of the task force shall serve without		
13	compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including				
14	travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties.				
15	No member of the task force shall be made subject to chapter 84,				
16	Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of that member's				
17	participa	tion	on the task force.		
18	(f)	The	task force shall submit a report of its findings		
19	and recom	menda	tions, including any proposed legislation, to the		
20	legislatu	ire no	later than December 31, 2018.		

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1	(g) The department of land and natural resources shall
2	provide administrative and clerical support to the task force.
3	(h) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 2019.
4	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
5	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
7	the administration and operation of the watershed task force.
8	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
10	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
