# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 431:3A-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[{] §431:3A-202[}] [Annual] Semiannual privacy notice to
- 4 customers required. (a) A licensee shall provide a clear and
- 5 conspicuous notice to customers that accurately reflects its
- 6 privacy policies and practices not less than [annually]
- 7 semiannually during the continuation of the customer
- 8 relationship. [Annually] For purposes of this section,
- 9 "semiannually" means at least once in any period of [twelve] six
- 10 consecutive months during which that relationship exists. A
- 11 licensee may define the [twelve consecutive month] six-
- 12 consecutive-month period, but the licensee shall apply it to the
- 13 customer on a consistent basis.
- 14 (b) A licensee shall not be required to provide [an
- 15 annual] a semiannual notice to a former customer. A former
- 16 customer is an individual with whom a licensee no longer has a
- 17 continuing relationship.



- 1 (c) If a licensee is required under this section to
- 2 deliver [an annual] a semiannual privacy notice, the licensee
- 3 shall deliver it according to section 431:3A-206."
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
