A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL OCEAN RECREATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many tourists who
- 2 visit the State participate in watersports in the oceans
- 3 surrounding the State, such as snorkeling, scuba diving,
- 4 kayaking, and surfing lessons. There are companies that conduct
- 5 commercial operations which take customers on excursions in
- 6 state waters for the purpose of engaging in recreation
- 7 activities. These commercial operations are required to obtain
- 8 a permit from the division of boating and ocean recreation of
- 9 the department of land and natural resources. However, the
- 10 provisions for obtaining those permits do not include any safety
- 11 requirements, which can lead to potential consumer safety
- 12 issues.
- 13 The legislature further finds that House Concurrent
- 14 Resolution No. 86, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, adopted in 2015, requested
- 15 the department of land and natural resources to engage
- 16 stakeholders to consider adopting permitting provisions
- 17 requiring employees of companies who take customers on



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- 1 watersport excursions to be trained in basic water safety
- 2 measures. The department has not taken action to carry out the
- 3 provisions of this resolution since its adoption.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 5 land and natural resources to adopt rules regulating the
- 6 activity of watersport excursion companies to provide for more
- 7 customer safety measures.
- 8 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
- 9 shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised
- 10 Statutes, by July 1, 2019, regulating the commercial ocean
- 11 operators that take customers into state waters for the purpose
- 12 of engaging in activities such as snorkeling, scuba diving,
- 13 kayaking, and surfing lessons. In adopting these rules, the
- 14 department shall require that:
- 15 (1) Commercial operators that allow customers to
- 16 participate in an activity in state waters away from a
- vessel maintain a ratio of at least one tour guide or
- instructor per eight participants;
- 19 (2) Each tour guide and instructor shall have a dive
- 20 master or lifequard certification from a nationally
- 21 recognized certification organization; and

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1	(3) Vessels used by commercial operators to transport
2	customers for the purpose of engaging in an activity
3	in ocean waters shall include a backboard and
4	emergency oxygen in onboard safety equipment.
5	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on December 24,
6	2088.
