A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER QUALITY MONITORING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the clean water
2	branch of the department of health has inadequate staff capacity
3	to meet its obligations to perform the timely monitoring that
4	ensures the island of Hawaii's stream and coastal water safety
5	for public swimming, fishing, and other recreation. In
6	particular, contaminants from waste water treatment plant
7	outfalls, injection wells, and cesspools need to be addressed
8	because of their role in harming coral reefs.
9	The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to the
10	department of health to establish an undetermined number of
11	positions to conduct water quality assessments on all streams
12	and coastal waters on the island of Hawaii, investigate
13	complaints, and enforce surface water regulations.
14	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the
17	clean water branch of the department of health to hire

1 full-time equivalent (FTE) environmental health 2 specialist IV employee to monitor and enforce the water quality 3 and safety of all Hawaii island's stream and coastal waters by: 4 (1) Acquiring water samples in Hawaii island streams, 5 coastal waters, and seeps; 6 (2) Conducting watershed assessments and various surface. 7 water tests; 8 (3) Investigating complaints; and 9 Enforcing surface water regulations. (4)10 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of health for the purposes of this Act. 11
