### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	allowed to drive in the left-most lane of an interstate highway:
9	(1) When a lane other than the left-most lane of an
10	interstate highway is closed by law enforcement
11	officers or emergency services personnel because of a
12	traffic incident, a traffic accident, or an emergency
13	road situation;
14	(2) In an area which the director of transportation
15	designates as unsafe, by rules adopted in accordance
16	with chapter 91; or

1	(3) Where there is only a single lane for traffic in each

3	(c) The director of transportation shall have the
4	authority to declare an emergency to allow heavy trucks to use
5	the left-most lane of an interstate highway.
6	(d) For the purposes of this section:
7	"Heavy truck" means any motor vehicle having a gross
8	vehicle weight of ten thousand pounds or more that is designated
9	or used primarily for the carriage of property other than the
10	personal effects of the driver or passengers and shall include a
11	motor vehicle to which has been added a box, platform, or other
12	equipment for such carriage. A heavy truck does not include an
13	emergency vehicle or mass transit vehicle as defined in section
14	291-11.6.
15	"Interstate highway" means any highway that is part of the
