BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 4 387-9 [and this section], every employer shall pay to each 5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 6 than: 7 \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; (1)8 (2)\$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 10 (4)\$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 11 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 12 \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [and] (6) 13 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018[-]; and (7) 14 (8) The rates established pursuant to subsection (b) beginning January 1, 2019. 15
