A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 183, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, created a
- 2 food safety certification costs grant program and the food
- 3 safety certification costs grant program special fund and
- 4 provided that the revenues of the special fund "shall consist of
- 5 legislative appropriations and interest thereon." Act 183
- 6 appropriated \$500,000 for fiscal year 2017-2018, but it did not
- 7 specify that these moneys were to be deposited into the special
- 8 fund, nor did it appropriate the moneys out of the special fund.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide that the amount
- 10 appropriated in Act 183, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, shall be
- 11 deposited into the food safety certification costs grant program
- 12 special fund and that the same amount shall be appropriated out
- 13 of the special fund for fiscal year 2018-2019.
- 14 SECTION 2. Act 183, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
- 16 "SECTION 2A. There is appropriated out of the food safety
- 17 certification costs grant program special fund the sum of



- 1 \$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 2 2018-2019 for the food safety certification costs grant program.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 agriculture for the purposes of this Act."
- 5 SECTION 3. Act 183, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017,
- 6 section 2, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 "SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 [for the
- 10 food safety certification costs grant program of the department
- 11 of agriculture.] to be deposited into the food safety
- 12 certification costs grant program special fund; provided further
- 13 that the funds appropriated shall lapse to the credit of the
- 14 general fund on June 30, 2019.
- 15 [The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 16 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.]"
- 17 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2018.
