# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERSONAL PRIVACY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by	
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read

8	government records maintained by the department of Hawaiian home	
9	lands shall not be required to be publicly disclosed or made	
10	open to inspection pursuant to public records requests under	
11	section 92F-11:	
12	(1) Loan applications, loan prequalification documents,	
13	loan approval documents, underwriting findings,	
14	financial data forms, and financial assessments except	
15	where disclosure is required by section 92F-12(a)(8);	
16	(2) Any consent to release personal information permitting	
17	the department of hawaiian home lands to access birth.
