PURPOSE:

To align the smoking prohibition statute of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA) with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) "smoke-free"

policy.

MEANS:

Amend section 356D-6.5(a) and (b), Hawaii

Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

Effective February 3, 2017, HUD instituted its final rule requiring public housing agencies (PHA) to implement a "smoke-free" policy. While a smoke-free policy or statute for the HPHA currently exists, changes need to be made to abide by Federal standards of no smoking up to 25 feet away from public housing and administrative office buildings.
