
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SHARING OF VITAL STATISTICS RECORDS WITH
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PROGRAM EMPLOYEES FOR APPROVED
RESEARCH PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§338- Sharing of vital statistics records with
5 department of health program employees for approved research
6 purposes. (a) Notwithstanding section 338-18, the department
7 may disclose public health statistics records to persons who are
8 employed by department of health programs, acting within the
9 scope of their employment, who need to use a public health
10 statistics record for research purposes, as approved by the
11 department of health's institutional review committee. Upon the
12 institutional review committee's approval, the department may
13 disclose the following to department employees as specified in
14 this section:

15 (1) Names, addresses, and contact information in the
16 record for the purpose of contacting persons



1 identified in the record to request informed consent
2 to use additional specified information in the record.

3 Upon confirmation of informed consent, the additional
4 specified information in the record may be disclosed
5 and used for approved research purposes; and

6 (2) Information in the record as approved by the
7 institutional review committee without informed
8 consent of persons identified in the record; provided
9 that the institutional review committee:

10 (A) Identifies the information in the record for
11 which disclosure is sought;

12 (B) Determines that obtaining informed consent is not
13 practicable; and

14 (C) Determines that there is a public health purpose
15 for the approved research that substantially
16 outweighs the confidentiality interest of persons
17 identified in the record.

18 (b) Research purposes under this section are limited to
19 those that have been approved by the department's institutional
20 review committee.



1 (c) Requirements for informed consent shall be determined
2 by the department's institutional review committee as part of
3 its approval of the research purposes for which the information
4 in the record will be disclosed and used.

5 (d) Information disclosed pursuant to this section may
6 only be re-disclosed:

7 (1) With authorization from the institutional review
8 committee; or

9 (2) If the record has been redacted of identifying
10 personal information.

11 (e) For the purposes of this section, "department" means
12 the department of health."

13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2035.



Report Title:

Vital Statistics Records; Disclosure within the Department for Approved Research Purposes

Description:

Authorizes the Department of Health, under specified circumstances, to disclose information in public health statistics records to Department employees acting within the scope of their employment for approved research purposes upon approval by the Department's Institutional Review Committee. Establishes conditions under which those records may be disclosed with and without informed consent. Takes effect 7/1/2035. (SD1)
