A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISPOSITION WITHIN STATE BOATING FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 200-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:				
3	"(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the board				
4	may lease fast lands and submerged lands within an existing				
5	state boating facility by public auction, a request for				
6	proposals, or by direct negotiation pursuant to section 171-59				
7	and chapter 190D, for private development, management, and				
8	operation; provided that [any lease of fast lands or submerged				
9	lands pursuant to a request for proposals shall be subject to				
10	section 200 2.6, regardless to which state boating facility the				
11	fast or submerged lands are attached.] no lease shall be				
12	approved by the board unless the board has first found that:				
13	(1) The lessee has considered the risk of sea level rise				
14	on the area of the land to be leased; and				
15	(2) The effect of sea level rise on the area of the land				
16	to be leased will be minimal during the term of the				
17	lease;				

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I	provided further that the board may request authorization from			
2	the legislature of, and the legislature may authorize, a lease			
3	that does not satisfy the criteria under paragraphs (1) and (2)			
4	where the board demonstrates the existence of extraordinary			
5	circumstances necessitating the lease.			
6	As used in this section, the term "state boating facility			
7	means a state small boat harbor, launching ramp, offshore			
8	mooring, pier, wharf, landing, or any other area under the			
9	jurisdiction of the department pursuant to this chapter."			
10	SECTION 2. Section 200-2.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
11	repealed.			
12	["[§200-2.6] Ala Wai boat harbor; leases. The fast lands			
13	and submerged lands of the Ala Wai boat harbor that may be			
14	leased include the following:			
15	(1) All fast lands and submerged lands described in the			
16	request for qualifications or request for proposals			
17	issued by the division of boating and ocean recreation			
18	of the department on November 25, 2008;			
19	(2) The fast land described as a portion of tax map key:			
20	(1) 2 3 37 12, composed of approximately 112,580			

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1	square feet, presently used for harbor office	s and
2	permitted vehicular parking; and	
3	(3) The fast land described as a portion of tax r	ap key:
4	(1) 2-3-37-12, which is a triangular area loc	ated
5	Diamond Head of Mole B, presently used for pe	rmitted
6	vehicular parking."]	
7	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and du	ities that
8	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings	that were
9	begun before its effective date.

11	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
12	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its ap	proval.

Report Title:

State Boating Facilities; Disposition

Description:

Before leasing any fast lands and submerged lands within any existing state boating facility by public auction, request for proposals, or direct negotiation, requires the board of land and natural resources to make a finding regarding certain sea level rise factors and allows legislative authorization for extraordinary circumstances. Repeals fast lands and submerged lands lease requirements specific to Ala Wai Boat Harbor. (SD1)

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
