### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY FOR OCEAN RECREATION AND COASTAL AREAS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 8  | (b) All rules shall be adopted in accordance with chapter       |
| 9  | 91 and shall have the force and effect of law.                  |
| 10 | (c) For the purposes of this section:                           |
| 11 | "Commercial activity" means to engage in any action or          |
| 12 | attempt to engage in any action designed for profit, including, |
| 13 | but not limited to, exchange or buying and selling of           |
| 14 | commodities; providing services relating to or connected with   |
| 15 | trade, traffic, or commerce in general; any activity performed  |
| 16 | by a commercial operator, its employees, or its agents in       |
| 17 | connection with providing services; and soliciting business,    |
| 18 | including, but not limited to, display or distribution of       |
| 19 | notices, business cards, or advertisements for commercial       |
| 20 | purposes. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the following shall    |
| 21 | not constitute a "commercial activity":                         |
