TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

PURPOSE: To amend the law relating to the driver's licensing requirement to operate an autocycle in the State.

MEANS: Amend section 286-71(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: It was the intent of the 2016 legislative session regarding Act 216 to allow individuals who possess a valid category 3 driver's license to operate an autocycle on Hawaii's public streets, roads, and highways. However, the measure that was passed references the incorrect paragraph of section 286-102(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

> Therefore, the purpose of this bill is to amend the autocycle driver's license requirement to reference 286-102(b)(3), Hawaii Revised Statutes. This housekeeping measure will appropriately align the legislative intent of Act 216 and the driver's licensing requirement.
