A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR CARRIERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 271-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended re	ead as follows:
3	"§27	1-4 Definitions. As used in this chapter:
4	(1)	"Chapter" means the Motor Carrier Law.
5	(2)	"Commission" means the public utilities commission.
6	(3)	"Person" or "persons" means any individual, firm,
7		copartnership, corporation, company, association, or
8		joint stock association; and includes any trustee,
9		receiver, assignee, or personal representative
10		thereof.
11	(4)	"Certificate" means a certificate of public
12		convenience and necessity issued under this chapter to
13		common carriers by motor vehicle.
14	(5)	"Permit" means a permit issued under this chapter to
15		contract carriers by motor vehicle.
16	(6)	"Transportation of persons" includes every service in
17		connection with or incidental to the safety, comfort,

1	or convenience of persons	transported and the receipt,
2	carriage, and delivery of	these persons and their
3	baggage.	

- (7) "Transportation of property" includes every service in connection with or incidental to the transportation of property, including in particular its receipt, delivery, elevation, transfer, carriage, ventilation, refrigeration, icing, dunnage, storage in transit, handling, and its consolidation for the purposes of forwarding within the State.
- 11 (8) "Motor vehicle" means any vehicle, machine, tractor, 12 trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by 13 mechanical power and used upon the highways in the 14 transportation of passengers or property, or any 15 combination thereof determined by the commission, but 16 does not include any vehicle, locomotive, or car 17 operated exclusively on a rail or rails or a trolley 18 bus operated by electric power derived from a fixed 19 overhead wire, furnishing local passenger 20 transportation similar to street-railway service.

1	(9)	nighway means the public loads, highways, streets,
2		and ways in this State.
3	(10)	"Rates" includes rates, fares, tolls, rentals, and
4		charges of whatever kind and nature unless the context
5		indicates otherwise [-]; provided that for
6		transportation by motor vehicle of passengers, where
7		the provision of transportation is part of a package
8		that may include air fare, meals, attractions, and
9		other services, "rate" shall only include the charges
10		for the provision of transportation by motor vehicle.
11	(11)	"Common carrier by motor vehicle" means any person
12		which holds itself out to the general public to engage
13		in the transportation by motor vehicle of passengers
14		or property or any class or classes thereof for
15		compensation.
16	(12)	"Contract carrier by motor vehicle" means any person
17		which engages in transportation by motor vehicle of
18		passengers or property for compensation (other than
19		transportation referred to in paragraph (11)) under
20		continuing contracts with one person or a limited
21		number of persons either (A) for the furnishing of

1		transportation services through the assignment of
2		motor vehicles for a continuing period of time to the
3		exclusive use of each person served, or (B) for the
4		furnishing of transportation services designed to meet
5		the distinct need of each individual customer.
6	(13)	"Motor carrier" includes both a common carrier by
7		motor vehicle and a contract carrier by motor vehicle.
8	(14)	"Private carrier of property by motor vehicle" means
9		any person not included in the terms "common carrier
10		by motor vehicle" or "contract carrier by motor
11		vehicle", who or which transports by motor vehicle
12		property of which the person is the owner, lessee, or
13		bailee, when such transportation is for the purpose of
14		sale, lease, rent, or bailment, or in the furtherance
15		of any commercial enterprise.
16	(15)	"Enforcement officer" means any person employed and
17		authorized by the commission to investigate any matter
18		on behalf of the commission. The term also means a
19		motor vehicle safety officer employed and assigned,
20		pursuant to section 271-38, by the department of
21		transportation to enforce sections 271-8, 271-12,
