A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that large, high-1 passenger vehicles pose an undue risk to public safety when 2 allowed in the fast lane of public highways. High-speed lane 3 changes are widely considered to be among the most dangerous 4 5 maneuvers, especially with regard to motorcyclists, whom the drivers of large semi-trucks may find difficult to see. 6 addition, efficiency suffers as trucks, trailers, and buses 7 cause congestion to the more nimble vehicles behind them. 8 9 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit large, highpassenger vehicles from using the fast lane of public highways. 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately 12 13 designated and to read as follows: Driving in left-hand lane or along left curb or 14 "§291Cedge; prohibitions. (a) Notwithstanding any contrary provision 15 in part XVII, no person driving a vehicle with more than four 16

wheels or a high-passenger car shall travel:

- 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 ""High-passenger car" means a passenger car, as defined in
- 5 section 286-2, designed for carrying at least eight passengers."
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 8 begun before its effective date.
- 9 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Statewide Traffic Code; Left-Lane, Zipper Lane, Diamond Lane

Description:

Prohibits drivers from operating vehicles with more than four wheels and high-passenger cars in the left lane, or close to the left-hand curb or left-hand edge, of a state or county roadway. Exempts drivers operating public transportation vehicles in a zipper lane or diamond lane.

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
