A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AN ACCESSIBLE PLAYGROUNDS PILOT PROGRAM FOR DISABLED CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. (a) There is established a three-year 1 accessible playgrounds pilot program to provide recreation 2 opportunities for children of all abilities. The pilot program 3 shall be developed and implemented by the department of 4 accounting and general services. The pilot program shall: 5 (1) Create, at minimum, one accessible playground in each 6 7 county; Obtain and consider community input before any design (2) 8 9 or construction takes place; Comply with all county zoning and land use 10 (3) regulations; and 11 Be subject to the requirements of chapter 104, Hawaii (4)12 Revised Statutes. 13 Each accessible playground shall: 14 (b)

Accommodate disabled children of all ages and their

adult caregivers;

 shall be completed and opened to the public no later than
 January 1, 2021.

 21 services shall submit a report on the results of the three-year

- 2 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 3 to the convening of the regular session of 2022. The report

- 5 playground utilization, community feedback, and operational and

- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
