
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) For members of Congress, state offices, county
4 offices, and the board of trustees for the office of Hawaiian
5 affairs, nomination papers shall be filed with the chief
6 election officer, or clerk in case of county offices, not later
7 than 4:30 p.m. on the first Tuesday in June[-]; provided that if
8 the incumbent of a non-at-large election does not file
9 nomination papers, then the chief election officer, or clerk in
10 case of county offices, shall accept nomination papers for that
11 office until 4:30 p.m. on the tenth day after the original close
12 of filing. However, in the event of a special primary or
13 special election, the filing deadline shall be determined in the
14 proclamation that is issued calling for the election as provided
15 for by state law or county charter. A state candidate from the
16 counties of Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai may file the declaration of
17 candidacy with the respective clerk. The clerk shall transmit
