A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the installation of 2 security cameras upon the property of a unit owner within a 3 condominium property regime may deter criminal activity on and 4 around the property. Additionally, the installation of security 5 cameras may provide recorded surveillance that can serve as 6 evidence in the criminal prosecution of offenders. 7 legislature further finds that the current approval processes 8 for security cameras can extend to great lengths of time, during 9 which potential criminal activity could occur that would 10 otherwise be mitigated if the owner were allowed to install the 11 equipment at will. Given this vital role of security cameras 12 for the protection of personal and real property, a governing 13 board should not have power over approval and disapproval of 14 said equipment. 15 The purpose of this Act is to authorize a unit owner to 16 install security cameras upon property solely owned by the unit

owner and that the installation of security cameras shall not be

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1	subject to or require approval from the board of directors of
2	the condominium association.
3	SECTION 2. Section 514B-140, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
5	"(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary in this
6	chapter or any provisions in any declaration or bylaws:
7	(1) Regarding the installment of telecommunications
8	equipment:
9	(A) The board shall have the authority to install or
10	cause the installation of antennas, conduits,
11	chases, cables, wires, and other television
12	signal distribution and telecommunications
13	equipment upon the common elements of the
14	project; provided that the same shall not be
15	installed upon any limited common element without
16	the consent of the owner or owners of the unit or
17	units for the use of which the limited common
18	element is reserved; [and]
19	(B) The installation of antennas, conduits, chases,
20	cables, wires, and other television signal

distribution and telecommunications equipment

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1			upon the common elements by the board shall not
2			be deemed to alter, impair, or diminish the
3			common interest, common elements, and easements
4			appurtenant to each unit, or to be a structural
5			alteration or addition to any building
6			constituting a material change in the plans of
7			the project filed in accordance with sections
8			514B-33 and 514B-34; provided that no
9			installation shall directly affect any
10			nonconsenting unit owner; and
11		(C)	A unit owner shall have the authority to install
12			or cause the installation of security video
13			telecommunications equipment upon property solely
14			owned by the unit owner and such installation
15			shall not be subject to or require approval by
16			the board;
17	(2)	Rega	arding the abandonment of telecommunications
18		equi	pment:
19		(A)	The board shall be authorized to abandon or
20			change the use of any television signal
21			distribution and telecommunications equipment due

1		to technological or economic obsolescence or to
2		provide an equivalent function by different means
3		or methods; and
4		(B) The abandonment or change of use of any
5		television signal distribution or
6		telecommunications equipment by the board due to
7		technological or economic obsolescence or to
8		provide an equivalent function by different means
9		or methods shall not be deemed to alter, impair,
10		or diminish the common interest, common elements,
11		and easements appurtenant to each unit or to be a
12		structural alteration or addition to any building
13		constituting a material change in the plans of
14		the project filed in accordance with sections
15		514B-33 and 514B-34; and
16	(3)	Regarding the installation of solar energy devices and
17		wind energy devices:
18		(A) The board shall have the authority to install or
19		cause the installation of, or lease or license
20		[+]common[+] elements for the installation of
21		solar energy devices and wind energy devices on

1		the common elements of the project; provided that
2		solar or wind energy devices shall not be
3		installed upon any limited common element without
4		the consent of the owner or owners of the unit or
5		units for which use of the limited common element
6		is reserved; and
7	(B)	The installation of solar energy devices and wind
8		energy devices on the common elements of the
9		project by the board shall not be deemed to
10		alter, impair, or diminish the common interest,
11		common elements, or easements appurtenant to each
12		unit or to be a structural alteration or addition
13		to any building constituting a material change in
14		the plans of the project filed in accordance with
15		sections 514B-33 and 514B-34; provided that the
16		installation does not directly affect any
17		nonconsenting unit owner."
18	SECTION 3	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 1 SECTION 4.
