BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that countries in the
Asia-Pacific region have experience and expertise in building
and maintaining public infrastructure.

No member of the working group shall be subject to 4 (q) 5 chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of the 6 member's participation in the working group.

7 The working group shall be dissolved on June 30, 2019. (h) This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 8 SECTION 3.
