A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1510, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]§302A-1510[+] Sustainable schools initiative. (a) 4 The department shall establish a goal of becoming net-zero with 5 respect to energy use, producing as much renewable energy as the department consumes across all public school facilities, by 6 7 January 1, 2035. 8 The department shall use the amount and value of 9 energy consumed by the department across all public school 10 facilities during the 2015-2016 fiscal year as the benchmark for 11 measuring the department's progress toward the energy usage goal 12 set forth in subsection (a). 13 The department shall submit an annual report that shall include information on: 14 15 (1) The overall progress toward the net-zero energy goal

set forth in subsection (a);

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1	(2)	Its plans and recommendations to advance the net-zero

3	(3)	Any challenges or barriers encountered or anticipated	
4		by the department in meeting the net-zero energy goal

6	(d)	The department shall expedite the cooling of all	
7	public sc	hool classrooms to a temperature acceptable for student	
8	learning.	When implementing classroom cooling measures, the	
9	departmen	t, and any contractor hired to implement classroom	
10	cooling measures, shall maximize energy efficiency and		
11	installat	ion and operating cost savings over the entire life of	
12	the proje	ect.	
13	<u>(e)</u>	The department shall establish and maintain a priority	
14	list of s	chools in need of classroom cooling; provided that	
15	beginning	with the 2018-2019 school year and every year	
16	thereafte	er, no less than fifty per cent of all funds	
17	appropria	ted to the department for classroom cooling projects	
18	shall be	made available for grants to schools on the priority	
19	list for	classroom cooling. The department shall allow any	
20	school on	the priority list to apply to the department for	


1	grants to	fund energy-efficient classroom cooling projects that	
2	have been	approved by the school's principal.	
3	[(e)] <u>(f)</u> Pursuant to this section, the department shall	
4	include i	n the report the status of the implementation of	
5	measures	taken to cool public school classrooms as required by	
6	subsection	n (d). The report shall include the following	
7	information:		
8	(1)	The number of completed classrooms in which cooling	
9		measures were implemented and the number of classrooms	
10		remaining that require cooling;	
11	(2)	The different types of cooling measures implemented;	
12	(3)	The approximate cost per classroom for planned cooling	
13		measures, including installation, upgrades, equipment,	
14		maintenance, and projected operating costs over the	
15		life of the installed cooling measures;	
16	(4)	The approximate cost per completed classroom for	
17		cooling measures implemented, including installation,	
18		upgrades, equipment, maintenance, and projected	
19		operating costs over the life of the installed cooling	
20		measures;	

1	(5)	The number of completed classrooms in which energy
2		efficiency measures were installed or implemented and
3		the number of classrooms remaining that require energy
4		efficiency measures; and
5	(6)	The different types of energy efficiency measures
6		installed or implemented.
7	[(£)]	(g) The department shall report its findings and
8	recommend	ations, including any proposed legislation, to the
9	legislatu	re no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
10	each regu	lar session."

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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Report Title:

Department of Education; Classroom Cooling Projects; School Priority List

Description:

Requires the Department of Education (DOE) to establish and maintain a priority list of schools in need of classroom cooling; provided that at least fifty percent of all appropriated funds for classroom cooling projects be made available for grants to schools on the priority list. Allows schools on the priority list to apply for DOE grants for energy-efficient classroom cooling projects.

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
