A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-1510, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"[+]§302A-1510[+] Sustainable schools initiative. (a)
The department shall establish a goal of becoming net-zero with
respect to energy use, producing as much renewable energy as the
department consumes across all public school facilities, by
January 1, 2035.

10 facilities during the 2015-2016 fiscal year as the benchmark for
11 measuring the department's progress toward the energy usage goal
12 set forth in subsection (a).

Report Title:

Department of Education; Classroom Cooling Projects; School Priority List

Description:

Requires the Department of Education to establish and maintain a priority list of schools in need of classroom cooling; provided that at least fifty percent of all funds appropriated for classroom cooling projects be made available for grants to schools on the priority list. Allows schools on the priority list to apply for Department of Education grants for energyefficient classroom cooling projects. (HB2484 HD1)
