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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF  
PRESIDENT THEODORE ROOSEVELT HIGH SCHOOL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that President Theodore  
2 Roosevelt high school was founded in 1930, is situated in  
3 Makiki, Oahu, and has grown to serve an enrollment of more than  
4 1,400 students. The school's existing gymnasium and music  
5 building were constructed over fifty years ago, and do not meet  
6 current department of education standards.

7           The legislature further finds that Act 106, Session Laws of  
8 Hawaii 2012, provided funding for plans and design for a new  
9 gymnasium, new music building, and additional on-site parking.  
10 The final master plan study (DOE Job No. Q22000-13) dated  
11 December 23, 2014, presented the preferred master plan for:

- 12           (1) A new gymnasium over a one-level parking structure at  
13           the site of the existing gymnasium; and  
14           (2) A new two-level music building and repurposing of the  
15           existing music building.



1           The legislature additionally finds that Act 49, Session  
 2 Laws of Hawaii 2017, provided funding for a new gymnasium with  
 3 locker rooms, classrooms, and other related facilities necessary  
 4 to provide equitable opportunities for girls and boys.

5           The purpose of this Act is to authorize the issuance of  
 6 general obligation bonds to provide funding for the  
 7 implementation of the master plan for the new gymnasium and new  
 8 music building for President Theodore Roosevelt high school.

9           SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
 10 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$29,325,000 or so much  
 11 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
 12 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019  
 13 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects at  
 14 President Theodore Roosevelt high school as follows:

15           A. Plans, design, construction, and equipment for a new  
 16 gymnasium with locker rooms, classrooms, and other  
 17 related facilities necessary to provide equitable  
 18 opportunities for girls and boys; ground and site  
 19 improvements; equipment and appurtenances.

4 B. Plans, design, and construction for a new music  
5 building with classrooms, practice rooms, teacher  
6 offices, and other related facilities; ground and site

13 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
14 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the  
15 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital  
17 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

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1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
