
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN OUTPATIENT CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for a
4 family medicine office practice and team-based training
5 outpatient center which will serve as the family medicine office
6 practice for the John A. Burns school of medicine family
7 medicine residency program.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
