16	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the farm to school		
17	grant program special fund the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much		
18	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the	
19	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
20	2018-2019 for the farm to school grant program to provide grant		
21	to farmer	s participating in the Hawaii farm to school program.
