1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2018-2019:

7 Design and construction for a five thousand square
8 foot parking lot on the mauka side of the school; and
9 ground and site improvements.
