BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§663- Exception to liability for county lifeguard services. (a) As used in this section: 5 "County lifequard" means a person employed as a lifeguard 6 7 by a county of this State. 8 "Employing county" means the county employing a county 9 lifeguard. (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, neither 10 a county lifequard, the employing county, nor the State shall be 11 12 liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or omission of the lifequard while providing rescue, resuscitative, or other 13
- employment as a county lifeguard. This exception from

 liability, however, shall not apply when the claim for civil

lifequard services on the beach or in the ocean in the scope of

- 1 damages results from a county lifeguard's gross negligence or
- wanton act or omission."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
